- The special meeting and proposed tax rate hearing was called to order by President of the Board, James Holt, with the following Board members present: James O. Lipscomb (Vice President), Lucy Knight (Director), and Fred Rothert (Director). Also present were Bob Wilson (PCCD Attorney) and PCCD staff Karen Bassett, Korey Schuelke and Daniel Meyer. Minutes were taken by Karen Bassett and transcribed by Korey Schuelke.
- 2:00PM President Holt opened the public hearing for the proposed tax rate for the Groundwater component of the Plum Creek Conservation District for 2011-2012.
- 2:00PM President Holt opened the public hearing for the proposed tax rate for the Flood Control component of the Plum Creek Conservation District for 2011-2012. President Holt then requested public comments. President Holt stated that there were no members of the public in attendance except for the Plum Creek Conservation District's Board of Directors and the Plum Creek Conservation District's staff.

(President Holt, Mr. Lipscomb, Mr. Twidwell, Mr. Rothert, and Mrs. Knight provided the assenting votes and Mr. Reinecke was not in attendance.)

Mr. Twidwell made a motion to approve the resolution setting the Plum Creek Conservation District's 2011-2012 tax rate for the Groundwater component at \$0.020 per \$100 of valuation. Mr. Lipscomb provided the second and the motion by
