PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT

1. To transmit Questions and Answers on the bid documents and make a pen-and-ink addition to Construction Specification 8.
2. To remind bidders that oral explanations or instructions given before the award of the contract will not be binding. See PART I, Subpart B, Instructions to Bidders, Section 6.

Offerors ***must acknowledge receipt of this Amendment no later than*** the hour and date specified in the IFB for receipt of sealed bids by one of the following methods:

Pen-and-Ink Change

PART IV: Construction Specification 8, Mobilization and Demobilization

ADD the following paragraph after Section 4.a.(2)(a):

- (b) The contractor will be allowed to go across the auxiliary spillway as part of this contract. The contractor is not allowed to use mats or build an improved road to cross the auxiliary spillway. The contractor is responsible for ensuring the function of the spillway is unimpeded during construction if they decide to use this route. Once the exact route is established, it shall not be relocated without approval from the Engineer. They are responsible for restoring the spillway to preconstruction condition (grade and vegetation). Should the spillway function during construction, the contractor is responsible for repairing those areas that were damaged on the spillway and around the disturbed areas caused by the contractor at no cost to the PCCD

QUESTIONS / ANSWERS

Q: Can the contractor use silt from the borrow area to form a berm in front of the riprap during construction?

A: It is up to the contractor to decide how to protect the excavation from water. This falls under their removal of water plan. The contractor is required to spread, blend and smooth the area to the existing grade of sediment pool prior to demobilization.

Q: Can the contractor build an access road using gravel to access the front face of the dam upstream of the excavation?

A: This falls under the means and methods of construction. The contractor is required to spread, blend and smooth the material to the existing grade of the sediment pool prior to demobilization. Material used for building the road is not a contract pay item.

Q: Can you provide an estimate of what Actual Damages might be per day?

A: We'd rather not speculate on a specific amount. See Part II, General Conditions, Article 5. Also see the administrative comments stated in IFB Amendment #1 (4/20/17), Page 4 of 14, under heading Exceeding Time in Contract for additional guidance.
