Plum Creek Conservation District's Board of Directors has determined that a mitigation plan should be considered by the District. The purpose of this proposed Mitigation Plan is to provide a means to allow a water well owner and/or water well user that has been granted legal authority to use the well and who alleges that his/her water well has been negatively impacted by the pumping of a neighboring water well the opportunity to apply for and seek mitigation.

The Plum Creek Conservation District Mitigation Plan involves a process of eight (8) phases which are:

1. Pre-Qualification.
2. Well Examination.
3. Data Compilation.
4. Mitigation Meeting.
5. Board Report.
6. Re-Hearing Request.
7. Final Board Ruling.
8. Compliance.
