

RESOLUTION AND ORDER DECLARING RESULTS OF  
ELECTION HELD IN PLUM CREEK CONSERVATION  
DISTRICT, CALDWELL AND HAYS COUNTIES, TEXAS,  
TO LEVY, ASSESS AND COLLECT ANNUAL AD VALOREM  
TAXES ON PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT

ON THIS, the 2nd day of October, 1959, the Board of Directors of Plum Creek Conservation District convened in session at the Plum Creek Conservation District Office, Lockhart, Texas, with the following members present, te-wit:

when, among other proceedings had, the following resolution and order was adopted:

There came to be considered the returns from the election held in Plum Creek Conservation District of Caldwell and Hays Counties, Texas, on the 26th day of September, 1959, upon the question of whether to levy, assess and collect annual ad valorem taxes on property within the District; and,

WHEREAS, it affirmatively appears that the aforesaid election was regularly ordered and held upon the question presented and that due notice was regularly given for the time and in the manner provided by law; and that the returns of said election were duly and legally made; and,

WHEREAS, it appears from the returns of said election that in respect of the proposition of whether to levy, assess and collect annual ad valorem taxes, there were cast at said election the total sum of 725 votes, of which number 520 votes were cast "FOR THE LEVYING, ASSESSING AND COLLECTING OF ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN CENTS (15¢)



ON THE ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$100.00) VALUATION"; and 185 votes were cast "AGAINST THE LEVYING, ASSESSING AND COLLECTING OF ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES":

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF PLUM CREEK CONSERVATION DISTRICT:

SECTION 1: That the foregoing findings are each and all confirmed and adopted as a part of this resolution and order by this reference.

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid election was duly and legally called and notice thereof given in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and the resolution and order calling for said election; that said election was held in strict conformity with the laws of the State of Texas, and returns thereof have been properly made to officials of the District entitled to receive the same and the same were canvassed by the Directors of the said District, as the law directs; that all qualified voters who are also property taxpayers in the District and who had duly rendered their property for taxation were permitted to vote at said election; and that said election properly represents the desires of those qualified to vote on the aforesaid proposition.

SECTION 3: That a majority of the qualified electors who are also property taxpayers in said District, voting at said election, have voted in favor of the proposition, "FOR THE LEVYING, ASSESSING AND COLLECTING OF ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN CENTS (15¢) ON THE ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$100.00) VALUATION": This Board is authorized to levy, assess and collect an annual ad valorem tax not to exceed Fifteen Cents (15¢) on the One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) valuation, on property situated with<sup>in</sup> the District.

The foregoing resolution and order having been read, it was moved by Charlie D. Geller, and seconded by W. W. Carmichael, Jr., that the same do pass.
