As a part of its business of exercising its groundwater powers, the Board of Plum Creek Conservation District will hold a hearing on applications for groundwater permits described as follows:

Summary of Permit:

This production permit is being used to supply a total of 6.6-acre feet of water (two wells at 3.3-acre feet each) to 14 RV sites at a total of 840 gallons/day. The total yearly use will be 306,600 gallons. Well #1 will produce at a rate of 16.59 GPM (gallons per minute) and well #2 will produce at a rate of 18.39 GPM with a combined GMP of 33 GPM. Both wells are completed in the Willcox Aquifer. Both wells are located at the Oak Knoll RV Park approximately 6 miles south of Lockhart.
